WHAT'S NEW WITH THE SEU?

Regulated entities would be wise to prepare for an increased level of scrutiny by the JFSC in 2019, and beyond.

As well as conducting examinations in response to known or perceived risks within individual entities, the JFSC's Supervision Examination Unit ("SEU") is planning a larger number of themed examinations.

An 'Outsourcing' themed review is currently underway. Focus will subsequently turn to 'The Role of the MLRO', 'Reliance' and 'Compliance Monitoring'. These broad themes address regulatory risks prevalent in industry and are areas where issues are commonly found.

The JFSC has also announced plans for the creation of a new team within the SEU, responsible for conducting AML/CFT specific examinations. The team is expected to be operational in Q3 2019.

In addition, the JFSC's refined supervisory approach means that those entities subject to Enhanced Supervision should expect two 'mini-examinations' and two review meetings in 2019. Those subject to Proactive Supervision should expect two review meetings.
